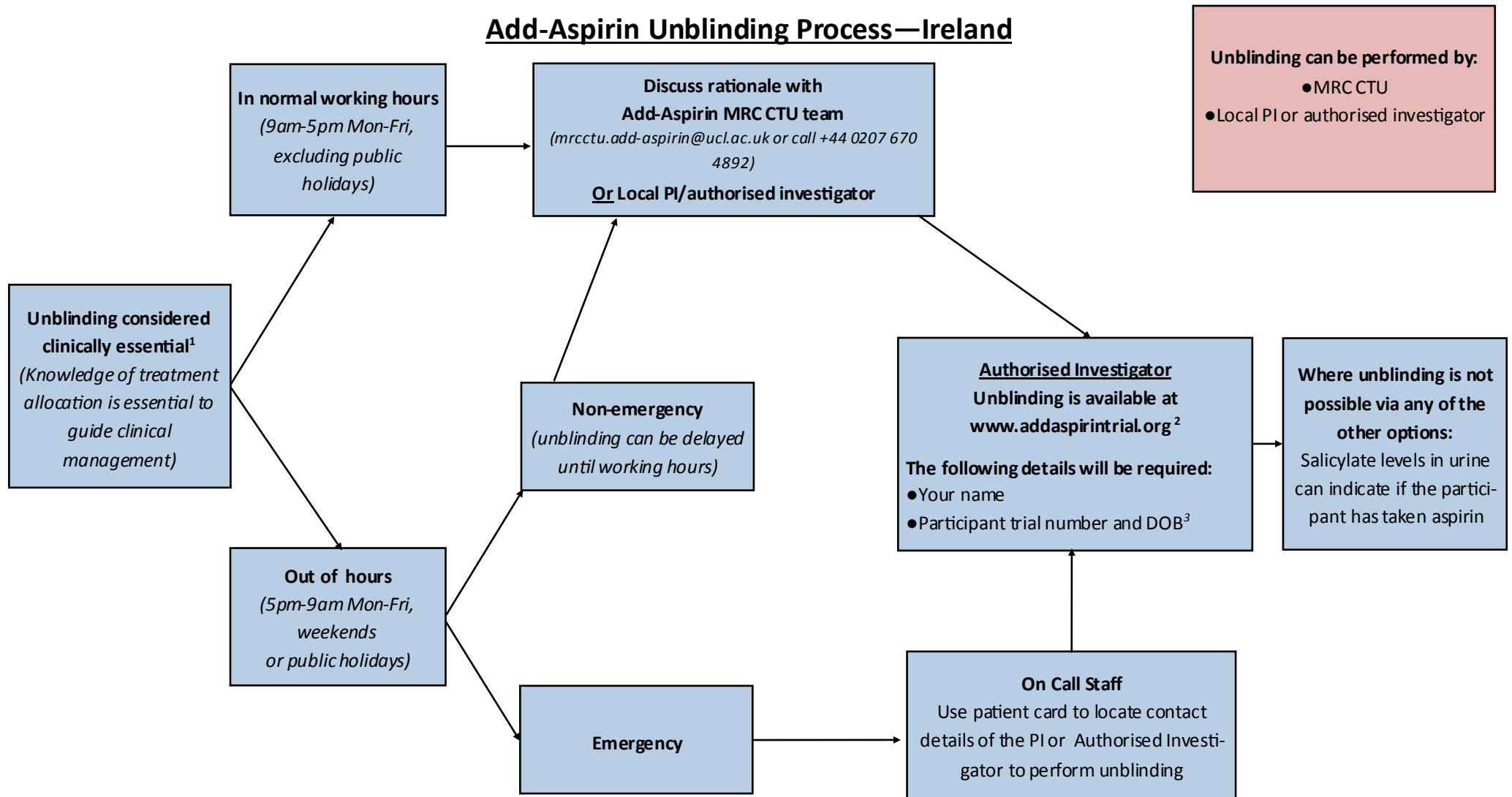


## Add-Aspirin Unblinding Process—Ireland

<sup>1</sup> Unblinding should only be performed where knowledge of treatment allocation is essential to guide clinical management and the patient cannot be managed by assuming they are taking 300mg of aspirin and/or withholding the trial medication (click [here](#) or go to [www.addaspirintrial.org](http://www.addaspirintrial.org) for clinical examples) . Please discuss with appropriate specialists where available.

<sup>2</sup> Please record reason for unblinding in participant’s notes and restrict knowledge of treatment allocation to those who need to know. The Add-Aspirin trial team will contact the unblinding doctor for further details the next working day.

<sup>3</sup> The participant’s trial number can be found on their trial card, if available, or can be obtained from the trial team at the hospital where they were recruited or from the MRC CTU team.

**PI:** Site Principal Investigator

**Authorised investigator:** Authorised investigators are investigators who have been delegated the task of unblinding by the Principal Investigator on the delegation of responsibilities log and granted access to unblind by the MRC CTU team
